Physics Contest Rules and Other Information

Physics Contest Rules:

- 1. The Physics Contest is open to students currently enrolled in first-year physics only.
- 2. No student is eligible to participate in the UNC Charlotte physics competitions more than once.
- 3. Due to the Super Competition schedule, participants in the Physics Contest will not be able to take the Chemistry test.
- 4. The physics written test will consist of multiple choice questions, all on mechanics only.
- 5. It will not be possible for students to begin the test late.
- 6. Maximum number of student participants: 10 per school.

Awards:

• Individuals:

 Awards will be presented to each of the <u>top three individual scorers</u> in the Physics Contest.

Teams:

- Physics contest <u>team scores</u> will be determined by <u>summing the five</u> highest scores made by the students on each school team.
 - Although there is officially no minimum number of participants per team, a school would have little chance of winning the team award for their category with fewer than five students participating.
 - Since only the five highest scores are to be used in determining the winning teams, there is no penalty for bringing more than the school's five best students.
- A trophy will be presented to the winning physics school teams (those with the highest collective score; see above) in each of two categories:
 - Top <u>public</u> school team
 - Top <u>private</u> school team
